The Philippine National Police Anti-Cybercrime Group (PNP-ACG), through RA Nr. 10964 dated December 29, 2017 otherwise known as the General Appropriation Act (GAA) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2020; and Approved Program of Expenditure (POE-PA) of the PNP Trust Receipt intends to apply for public bidding on following items:

- 2. The PNP ACG now invites bids for the supply and delivery of GOODS is required FIFTY (50) CALENDAR DAYS from the receipt of the Notice to Proceed (NTP). Bidders should have completed, within five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.
- 3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".
- 4. Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.
- 5. Interested bidders may obtain further information from PNP ACG BAC Secretariat and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during Office hours from 8:00AM to 5:00PM from Mondays to Fridays except holidays.

- 6. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on March 6, 2020 from the address below, upon payment of the non-refundable bidding fee for the Bidding Documents.
 - It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.
- 7. The PNP ACG will hold a <u>Pre-Bid Conference¹ on March 6, 2020 at Exactly 2:00PM</u> at PNP ACG Conference Room, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
- 8. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat at the address below on or before 2:00PM March 19, 2020, All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB.
 - <u>Bid opening shall be on March 19, 2020 2:30PM</u> at PNP ACG Conference Room. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.
- 9. The PNP ACG reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
